

# BFA Reunion, Toowoomba 2023

## Ideas for getting to and from Toowoomba for the reunion: 6-8 October 2023

To get to Toowoomba, most people will fly to Brisbane and then transfer by road to Toowoomba. Alternatively, there are flights directly to Toowoomba from Brisbane, Sydney but it should be borne in mind that flights to Toowoomba are limited.

### **Getting to Toowoomba after flying to Brisbane**

If you fly to Brisbane and do not have a rental car booked, you can travel directly from the Domestic Terminal to Toowoomba by bus by Greyhound (for about \$35 each way) or Murrays Coaches (~\$42 to \$49 each way).

**Greyhound** operates direct services from Brisbane Domestic Terminal to Toowoomba daily. These services depart from Bus and Coach stop A1-A2 in front of the Domestic Terminal. The Greyhound services arrive and depart from Platform 1 at the Toowoomba Bus Interchange in Neil Street, Toowoomba.

**Murrays Coaches** operates direct services from Brisbane Domestic Terminal to Toowoomba daily. These services depart from Bus and Coach Bay D in front of the Domestic Terminal. The Greyhound services arrive and depart from Platform 1 at the Toowoomba Bus Interchange in Neil Street, Toowoomba.

The Bus Interchange is approximately a 10-minute walk from the Burke and Wills hotel which is our base for the reunion. Other hotels located close by include Toowoomba Central Plaza Hotel and the Oaks Toowoomba.

### **Flying to Toowoomba**

If you fly directly to Toowoomba's airport at Wellcamp, there are several options of getting to and from the airport.

Two airlines serve Wellcamp airport. They are QANTAS and Regional Express (REX Aviation). QANTAS operate services from Sydney to Toowoomba, while Regional Express operate flights from Brisbane and several other regional locations.

## **QANTAS**

QANTAS operates services between Sydney and Toowoomba:

### **Sydney to Wellcamp**

- QF 1412 operates on Mondays, Fridays, and Saturdays, departing SYD at 0710 and arriving at Wellcamp (WTB) at 0750.
- QF 1414 operates on Thursdays, Fridays, and Sundays departing SYD at 1710 and arriving at WTB at 1750.

### **Wellcamp to Sydney**

- QF 1411 operates on Mondays, Fridays, and Saturdays departing WTB at 0820 and arriving SYD at 1100.
- QF 1413 operates on Thursdays, Fridays, and Sundays departing WTB at 1820 and arriving SYD at 2100.

Please check with QANTAS on phone 131 313 or their website at <https://www.qantas.com/us/en.html> for any updates. All flights are operated by de Havilland Canada DHC-8 (Dash 8) aircraft.

## **Regional Express (REX Aviation)**

Regional Express operate flights between Wellcamp (WTB) and Brisbane (BNE) twice per week:

- ZL 5631 operates on Wednesdays and Sundays departing BNE at 0800 and arriving at WTB at 0840.
- ZL5632 operates on Wednesdays and Sundays departing WTB at 1630 and arriving BNE at 1710.

## **Transport from/to Toowoomba Wellcamp Airport**

At Toowoomba Airport, you can hire rental cars from the following companies:

AVIS, Budget, Europcar, Hertz, and Thrifty.

Taxis are available and await all arriving flights. The taxi service is provided by Black and White Taxis and can be booked in advance by contacting them on phone 133 222 or at their website at [www.blackandwhitescabs.com.au](http://www.blackandwhitescabs.com.au). There is also a courtesy phone located near the baggage carousel.

Darling Downs Transport Services also provide pre-booked services to and from hotels and motels. They provide a Silver Service taxi for a maximum of 4 passengers. A minibus for up to 6 passengers and a large mini bus for up to 11 passengers can be booked for family groups.
